The Challenge



After more than a decade online and through multiple iterations, RMNB's website had become difficult to manage and outdated in both functionality and form.

The backend workflow was fragmented, and blog contributors especially those not fluent in WordPress—found publishing to be slow and cumbersome.

As the site grew, so did the need for improved performance, better mobile responsiveness, and a refreshed design that still retained the beloved RMNB identity.

The Solution

ArachnidWorks' redesign had two guiding principles: (1) preserve the personality of a beloved blog and (2) radically improve how it functions behind the scenes.

Putting these principles into practice, the design and development team:

- Led a full redesign of the site's front-end experience, updating the look while retaining the charm and identity that RMNB readers have come to expect.
- Rebuilt the site on a custom WordPress framework, eliminating legacy plugins and inefficient templates that were slowing down performance.
- Developed a streamlined publishing workflow, including intuitive post-creation tools, simplified media management, and a flexible tagging system all designed to make life easier for RMNB's editorial team.
- Enhanced site speed and mobile responsiveness, ensuring fans could access content quickly and cleanly from any device.
- Integrated smarter ad placements and monetization tools, supporting RMNB's desire to grow revenue without compromising the reader experience.


Ovechkin came into the series against Carolina as the team's leading playoff goal scorer with four goals in five games against the Montreal Canadiens. To
